## 2016 Seedling / Plant List

*All seeds started from non-gmo seed and grown without chemicals.*

### Peppers:

- **Jalapeno:** Basic green jalapeno peppers perfect for salsa and more
- **Christmas Tree Hot Peppers:** 1" long red, hot cayenne peppers
- **King of the North:** Bell shaped peppers green ripening to red
- **Ralph Thompson's Squash Pepper:** Red squatty, mildly hot peppers shaped like tiny pumpkins
- **Italian Pepperoncini:** Small 3-5 inch peppers with a touch of heat, perfect for pickling
- **Canary Bell:** Yellow bell sweet peppers with thick walls.

### Tomatoes:

- **White Currant:** Cherry type, yellowish white. Prolific producer, bushy plant. Saved from our seed.
- **Black Vernissage:** Produces 2 ounce reddish-black tomatoes. Great for sauces. Saved from our seed.
- **German Lunchbox:** Small, pink egg shaped. Sweet and great for salads.
- **Amana Orange:** Large 1-lb orange beefsteak type.
- **Earliana:** Small plants (about 3 feet tall) producing red tomatoes in the 4 ounce range.

### Slicing Cucumbers:

- **Straight Eight:** Smooth, straight, deep green 8" cucumbers with rounded ends. Vigorous.
- **Marketmore 76:** Dark green, 8-9" cucumbers, great yields.
- **Muncher:** Tender, nearly spineless, & plump. Vigorous vines.

### Pickling Cucumbers:

- **National Pickling:** 6 inch blunt, dark green with some striping. Slight taper perfect for jars.
- **De Bourbonne:** Tiny pickling cucumbers for the cornichon style pickles.
- **Boston Pickling:** Vigorous vine, large yields smooth green cucumbers. Crisp great pickles.

### **Summer Squash:**

- **Cocozelle Zucchini:** Long dark green zucchini with light green vertical stripes. Prolific.

### **Miscellaneous Plants:**

- **Purple Tomatillos:** Grows in a husk and turns purple when ripe.
- **Marigold:** A variety of colors and shapes, old-fashioned and long-lasting flowers. Started from our saved seed.
- **Greyhound Cabbage:** Early summer variety with cone shaped heads
- **Calabrese Broccoli:** Produces heads about 5" across with many side shoots all summer long

### **Herbs: Culinary & Medicinal:**

- **Calendula:** Red, orange, and yellow blooms. Started from our saved seed.
- **Elecampane** (*Inula helenium*): Yellow flowering perennial.
- **Fennel:** This is a seed fennel variety not a bulb and is considered a hardy perennial.
- **Feverfew** (*Tanacetum parthenium*): Perennial to -20 degrees
- **Holy Basil: Kapoor Tulsi** (*Ocimum santum*): Annual and flowers easily, pinch of heads often
- **Mugwort** (*Artemisia vulgaris*): Perennial and a vigorous spreader, grows 3-4 feet tall
- **Lime Basil**
- **Sage**
- **Thyme**
- **White Horehound** (*Marrubium vulgare*): Annual in the Flathead Valley, hardy to only 10 degrees.
